- ✓ Open to all research topics, methodologies and disciplines represented at the University, including the humanities, social sciences, business studies, economics, law, computer science and mathematics
- Funding for academic events to be held in Passau, in cooperation with PICAIS
- Applicable for members of the University of Passau and external co-organisers (with a doctorate)
