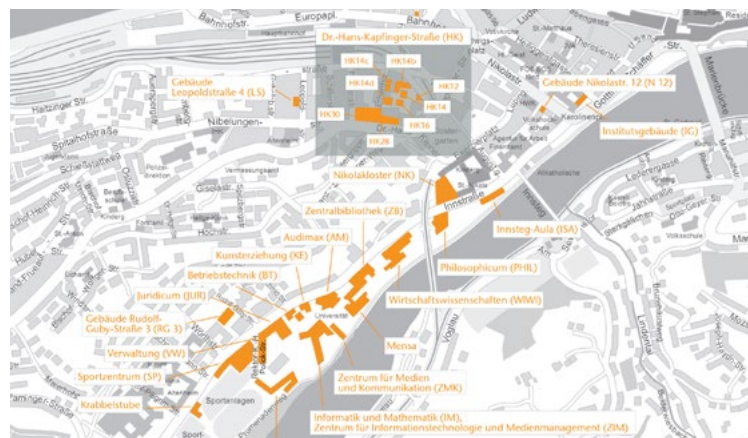


Why Passau?

What does PICAIS do?

The Passau International Centre for Advanced Interdisciplinary Studies (PICAIS) is the central platform for academic excellence and interdisciplinary research at the University of Passau.

PICAIS

- funds interdisciplinary project ideas and events through fellowship programmes and event funding
- supports the advancement of early career researchers
- provides unique network-building opportunities
- integrates international visiting scholars into the University's academic community
- hosts inspiring lecture series

PICAIS started its activities in spring 2021. Ever since, it has become a vibrant platform for cooperation and exchange with scientists and scholars of international standing.

In addition, PICAIS aims to establish a unique culture of collegial, transparent, open-minded and interdisciplinary collaboration.



What programmes does PICAIS offer?

Research-in-Residence Fellowship

- Funding of a visiting position for Junior or Senior researchers
- Duration: 2 – 6 months
- Eligibility: external researchers holding a doctorate
- Applications must be endorsed by a member of the University of Passau, who will act as their host

Event Funding

- Funding of academic events to be held in Passau
- Aims at international networking and cooperation between researchers at different career stages; exchange of ideas on innovative research issues
- Eligibility: members of the University of Passau and external co-organizers (with a doctorate)

PICAIS' research promotion activities are particularly oriented towards the **University's strategic guiding themes**:

- Europe
- Sustainability
- Digitalisation

Whilst there is no restriction on research topics, priority is given to topics that are related to one or more of our strategic guiding themes.

The **deadlines for online applications** to the PICAIS grant programmes are **May 15** and **October 15** each year.

Who can apply?

The application is open to researchers from **all research topics, methodologies and disciplines represented at the University**, including the humanities, social sciences, business studies, economics, law, computer science and mathematics.

The **Fellowship programme** is aimed at both internationally outstanding **established academics** and promising **early career researchers** who, having completed their doctoral study, wish to advance their academically excellent and innovative research ideas and international projects.

The **Event Funding programme** provides funding for both subject-specific and inter-/transdisciplinary formats. The programme is open to all forms of academic events that promote scholarly debate and analysis of important research questions and/or help to initiate or enhance international cooperation and networking.
