Are you interested in applying for the “Global Minds Initiative Germany: Humboldt Research Fellowship” and looking for a host institution in Germany?

PICAIS (Passau International Centre for Advanced Interdisciplinary Studies) invites expressions of interest from excellent international researchers who wish to apply for a Humboldt Research Fellowship at the University of Passau.

Application Procedure

Interested candidates are invited to submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) including:

- a summary of the proposed research project (up to three pages, excluding references),
- an up-to-date tabular CV.

You may already suggest a potential host at the University of Passau; however, this is not required. PICAIS will review all submissions and select promising projects. Selected candidates will be supported in identifying a suitable host at the University of Passau and in preparing their application to the Humboldt Foundation.

In the event of a successful Humboldt application, fellows will become part of the PICAIS research community and benefit from its international, interdisciplinary, and collaborative environment.

1. Quality and feasibility of the proposed research project
2. Research profile of the applicant
3. Potential contribution to the University of Passau

PICAIS is committed to fostering social and intellectual diversity and particularly encourages applications from female researchers to promote gender equality.

The selection process is typically completed within four weeks after the application deadline.
